



# Aoton Roditis 2015 PGI Attiki

**Score 16.5/20**

*100% Roditis (Alepeou clone with smaller berries). Tank fermentation, no oak.*

Less aromatic than the Savatiano. Delicate and minerally on the nose, just a touch of lime fruit. Dry, juicy and crisp on the palate. Less intense perhaps than the Savatiano but with good depth for a generally lightish variety. Mouth-watering, tight finish. (JH)
